

CARETAKER

In 2023 the club saw an increase in the number of visitors coming to enjoy our clubs' amenities and friendly atmosphere. Beautification, maintenance, and facility upgrades had much to do with our success.

Keeping the club well maintained is an absolute must. Our new board must decide how we can best accomplish this in 2024. We need to find out if someone is interested in the Caretaker position or we need the members to share the different tasks. Position pays \$500 per month.

In 2023 we had a caretaker and some of the other members shared responsibility for the pool and hot tub.

Some, not all, of the duties include the following:

Commit to being on the mountain full time Monday – Friday from April 15 to October 15 (weather permitting) and spend 15 to 20 hours per week.

Opening and closing the mountain – Water, Pool, Hot Tub, Repair water leaks, gate update and repair

Covering and uncovering the pool daily

Mowing and weed eating the common grounds on Thursdays.

Cleaning and stocking the outhouses, including the pool outhouse, weekly. More often if we have events.

Keeping all decks and stairs clean and free from needles, etc.

Clean outside cabin areas, rental lots, clubhouse, laundry room and equipment room

Taking out garbage from clubhouse area, outhouses, and rental lots

Pool and hot tub – clean and maintain chemicals (or oversee if we have someone else do this)

OR

The other alternative is to have other members or couples sign up for a week to two-week commitment. So far, Ted and Cindy have committed to the first 6 weeks starting April 15th and open the mountain, which would include turning on the water and starting up the pool and hot tub. (Weather permitting). This is always the most demanding part of the position. The rest of the year is more about cleaning and maintenance phase.

If we could fill the calendar with volunteers, then the club could save \$4,000 for the year. This money could be used for other needed projects (a new laundry facility could be an option). No suggestion is off the table.

With more members, we could also do needed projects like a new laundry facility with adequate storage for activity supplies, or a new clubhouse – The ideas are endless!


